The excitement of the much anticipated Trivia Challenge between the District Leadership of 7305 and the North Allegheny High School Interact Club did not disappoint.


Each team was asked 30 questions, 10 from each of the following categories: General Knowledge, Past and Current Events and Rotary Knowledge. Here is the “box score” for each team at the end of 30 questions:

**District Leadership:** General Knowledge got 7 out of 10 correct; Past & Current Events 8 out of 10 correct and Rotary Knowledge 5 out of 10 correct for a score of 20.

**North Allegheny:** General Knowledge got 7 out of 10 correct; Past & Current Events 9 out of 10 correct and Rotary Knowledge 4 out of 10 correct for a score of 20.

Being tied it came down to a sudden death with teams being sent to breakout rooms and asked the same five questions. Emerging from the breakout rooms, North Allegheny answered 3 questions correctly while the District Leadership answered two questions correctly. **NORTH ALLEGHENY** won by 1 point.
